'Sneak a Peek' at the Dubuque International Film Festival!

During 'Sneak a Peek' three films representing various genres are **scheduled each evening beginning at 7:00 p.m.** For the **Tuesday, April 21st** screening, two short films are grouped around a Danish dramatic feature titled "**Backgammon**". "Backgammon", through a redeeming narrative and richly textured, lushly photographed canopy, explores issues related to childhood abuse. Format on **Wednesday, April 22nd** is the same, two shorts grouped around a documentary, "**The Breach**". "The Breach" investigates 'Earth Day' related content, showing how a Native Alaskan attempts to conserve and guarantee the sustainability of a Salmon fishery. The '**Sneak a Peek**' films will not be shown in Dubuque. Tickets are modestly priced at \$8.00 for each evening, and may be purchased at the door. Seating is limited to 90 viewers.
